# 2018 Czech Open Under 19 Championships (YOG ranking competition)

# Prague, Czech Republic, from 11th May to 13th May 2018









Dear Friends.

The Czech Modern Pentathlon Association in cooperation with ASC Dukla Praha has the pleasure of inviting a delegation of your country to participate in the 2018 Czech Open Under19 Championships, YOG ranking competition, that will be held in Prague, 11<sup>th</sup> May to 13<sup>th</sup> May 2018. The schedule of competitions will depend on the number of registered athletes:

11<sup>th</sup> May Friday
Arrival of participants
20:30 Technical Meeting (Hotel Diplomat)

- If the number of male and female athletes is less than 38

12<sup>th</sup> May Saturday – Women's individual competition 3<sup>th</sup> May Sunday – Men's individual competition

or

- If the number of male and female athletes is more than 38

12<sup>th</sup> May Saturday – Women's and Men's individual qualifications 20:30 Technical Meeting Women's and Men's finals (Hotel Diplomat)

13<sup>th</sup> May Sunday – Women's and Men's individual finals

or

- If the number of female athletes is less than 38 and male athletes more than 38 (or vice versa)

12<sup>th</sup> May Saturday – Men's (or Women's) individual qualifications 20:30 Technical Meeting Women's and Men's finals (Hotel Diplomat)

13<sup>th</sup> May Sunday – Women's and Men's individual finals

Time schedule will be specified after the deadline of entry form C

The competition will be carried out according to the current UIPM Rules.

Swimming: 25 m indoor swimming pool / 6 lanes (Juliska)

Fencing: 10+1 pistes (Pod Juliskou)

Laser-run: 36+3 (38+1) precision laser targets (PLT); tartan (Juliska) spikes can

be used

#### **Entries**

- 1. The U19 Tetrathlon competition will count towards Youth Olympic Games World Ranking List (YOGPWR) U19 (YA), for athletes born 2000 2003 if fulfilling criteria according to UIPM Competition Rules 1.19.2
- 2. For the U19 Tetrathlon competition the maximum number allowed is 4 athletes per nation and gender. The host nation can compete with 6 athletes per gender UIPM Competition Rules 1.12.8 (if free places)

#### **FINANCIAL CONDITIONS**

As it is approved by the UIPM, all delegation members (including athletes, coaches and officials) have to pay as follows:

- € 75 for double room per night per person
- € 95 for single room per night per person

Prices include entry to the competition, local transport, accommodation - 1 night in single or double room with breakfast, lunch packet (lunch only on the competition days) and dinner. (The meal begins with dinner on the day of arrival and ends with breakfast on the day of departure).

Delegations are required to send by bank transfer a minimum of 30 percent of the total amount of their accommodation invoice until 15<sup>th</sup> April, otherwise the reservation will not be guaranteed. After receiving final Form C and the non-refundable 30 percent deposit, we will send you an invoice for the remainder of the total cost for your delegation. This may be paid in cash (Euros only) at the accreditation desk on arrival, or sent by bank transfer in advance.

The payee will be responsible for all bank charges incurred by Cesky svaz moderniho petiboje (Czech Modern Pentathlon Association) for bank transfers and must select this option when making the payment.

Nations wishing to arrange their own accommodation, an accreditation fee must be paid per participant (athletes and coaches) to the LOC. This is set at € 80 per competition day per person, which is required to be paid in cash at the accreditation desk on arrival.

For this, we will provide lunch packets for the competition days and allow access to official transportation between competition sites.

#### **TRANSPORT**

Transportation from the nearest airport (or railway station) to the official hotels and the return journey is only guaranteed if arrival information is provided in good time and according to the deadline on Entry Form C. Transportation from the official hotels to the venue for athletes will be according to the competition programme.

#### **ENTRY FORMS**

Deadlines for the Entry Forms are as follows:

Form A (informative): before 20<sup>th</sup> March Form B (preliminary): before 5<sup>th</sup> April Form C (final): before 15<sup>th</sup> April

If, on arrival for the competition, the team has less athletes and/or team officials/coaches than listed on their Final Entry Form and without informing the Organizing Nation/LOC at least 7 days prior to their arrival, the NF will pay a fine to the Organizing Nation/LOC of 200 Euros for each person not attending.

#### **INSURANCE and ATHLETES' LICENSES**

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they are in possession of a valid UIPM issued Athletes License. According to UIPM Rules all members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidental injury or illness. The organizer will not accept any responsibility financial or other, for any loss, injury or illness of any member of the delegation.

## **EQUIPMENT CONTROL**

Fencing equipment control take place on the piste before the start of the first bout. Pistol check will generally take place at competition site and starts 120 minutes before Laserrun starts. It will be possible to check your shooting equipment on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> May or Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> May, from 11 p.m. at the shooting range as well.
