ENTRIES

1. For the U19 Tetrathlon competition the maximum number allowed is 4 athletes per nation and gender. The host nation can compete with 6 athletes per gender - UIPM Competition Rules 1.12.8 (if free places)
2. For U17 Triathlon the invitation is for unlimited number of the athletes and coaches per nation, but based on the received preliminary entries, the LOC, reserve the right to reduce the overall number of the athletes per NF.

COMPETITION RULES

The competitions will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules.

- Swimming: 50m or 25m swimming pool-details and location (TBC)
 Fencing: 8 pistes
 Laser-Run: 30+2 Laser Targets (Pentashot)
 Running course: Asphalt tiles, 800m lap.

ACCOMMODATION

On own arrangement.

If it needed LOC can provide an accommodation option, the price is 65 euro per person in the DBL room, and 85 euro in the single room. Price includes transportation from Hotel to the Competition Venue and back to the Hotel. Breakfast in the hotel – optionally, 6 euro per person/per day.

Please note that the Technical Meeting, Accreditation Office, LOC Office and etc. will be located within the competition venue.

TRANSPORTATION

On own arrangement. LOC can recommend the transfer options from Tbilisi International Airport (TBS) if needed.

FININCIAL CONDITIONS

Accreditation fee - 20 euro per Athlete and per Coach.

The payment can be made via bank transfer or by cash to LOC on arrival.

ATHLETES LICENSES

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they are in possession of a valid Athletes License. Registration is not possible without a License Number. The Athletes who do not have a license will not be allowed to take part in the competition.

INSURANCE

According to the UIPM Rules all Delegation members should insure themselves in case of accidental injury or illness. The organizer will not accept any responsibility financial or otherwise for loss, injury or illness of any Delegation member.

LASER PISTOLS

Firearms Licenses are not a legal requirement when bringing air and CO2 pistols into Georgia for competition purposes.

VISA SUPPORT

Visiting nations should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into Georgia prior travelling to the event. The LOC cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas, but can provide specific letters of invitation if needed. Delegates who require an invitation letter to acquire an entry visa for Georgia, should write the specifying details to the Georgian Modern Pentathlon Federation and LOC. Please note that this procedure aims to assist delegates who need to obtain a visa or permission to attend the event. It is not an official invitation covering fees or other expenses and does not imply any financial support.

Georgia is visa friendly country which doesn't require visa for a nations from the most countries. An official list of all countries whose citizens don't require a visa to enter Georgia as well as e-visa regulations can be found following the link:
