The examination must not have taken place more than one year prior to the submission of the entry form.</p>
Eligibility:	Every member of a sports club within the DOSB or the equivalent national federation of his/her country is eligible to participate. Currently excluded from participation are athletes with the right to start for a club or federation from Russia or Belarus.
Pair Relays:	A pair relay consists of two athletes. Men / Women or Single Mixed (one female athlete and one male athlete). An athlete can only compete in one pair relay. The age-groups may be different. Up to seniors the older age-group always counts, from seniors onwards the younger age-group always counts for the classification.

Mixed Relays:	Four athletes (2 female / 2 male) form a mixed relay. The order is optional. If athletes of more than one age-group start together, the relay team will be entered in the age-group of the oldest competitor up to the senior class, and in the masters age-groups in the age-group of the youngest competitor. If masters start with athletes of the classes seniors or younger, the relay will be evaluated as seniors. The shooting distances shall be determined analogously up to the senior class by the class of the oldest competitor, in the masters age-groups by that of the youngest competitor.
Awards:	<p>German Championships: The winners of each age-group in the German classification will be awarded the title of German Champion, the top three will receive medals. The winners of each age-group of the German classification of the relays will be awarded the title German Relay Champion, the first three will receive certificates. Eligible to participate in the German Championships are members of a club within the DOSB with permanent residence in Germany.</p> <hr/> <p>Baden-Württemberg Championships: The winners of each age-group of the Baden-Württemberg classification will be awarded the title of Baden-Württemberg Champion, the top three will receive medals. The winners of each age-group of the Baden-Württemberg classification of the relays will be awarded the title of Baden-Württemberg relay champion, the first three will receive certificates. Athletes who are members of a club within the VMFBW are eligible to participate in the Baden-Württemberg Championships. residence in Germany.</p> <hr/> <p>Open classification: In the various competitions, an open classification will be carried out for age-groups with international participation. All participants will be considered for the open classification. The winners of each age-group in the Open classification will be awarded the title of Winner. The winners of each age-group in the open classification of the relays will be awarded the title of relay winner.</p>
Pistols / Targets:	Hit & miss targets with hit indicator lights will be provided by the organiser. The participants should use their own laser pistols. On loan, pistols will be issued by the organiser for a fee of 5 € for the duration of the competition (please specify when registering).
Liability:	The organisers accept no liability for accidents, theft or other incidents of any kind. In all other respects, the statutory regulations shall apply.
