Competition The rules of the DVMF competition regulations Laser-Run in the valid version apply:

Competition categories and age groups:

Elite and open category: U9 to Masters 70+ (individual and mixed/WW/MM relay teams)

Fun category: U9 to Masters 70+ (individual and relay teams)

Participants: Elite category

Athletes who are members of a sports club that belongs to a DVMF state association, have a properly valid DVMF sports pass with a 2025 annual license and have permanent residence in

Germany (with a corresponding residence permit).

Open category and fun category

Anyone can take part in competitions in the Open category and the Fun category.

Athletes with starting rights for a club or federation from Russia or Belarus are currently

excluded from participation.

Each participant is responsible for his/her own health. Participation of minors in the elite category and in the open category only with a valid health certificate (not older than 1 year).

Rankings: For all age groups, in addition to the classification of the elite categories, a combined overall

classification with the open category will be held.

There will be a separate ranking for all age groups in the fun category.

Relay teams whose relay partners belong to different age groups are assigned to the age group with the higher performance. If Masters start with athletes in the Junior age group or

younger, the relay team will be classified in the Senior age group.

Several age groups may start in one race.

Titles, awards and ranking points:

German champion

The title of German Champion is only awarded to participants in the elite category. The top three

in each age category receive medals; all receive certificates.

All participants in the elite category will also receive ranking list points in accordance with the DVMF Laser Run competition regulations. A competition weighting factor of 2 is applied when

calculating the ranking points.

German relay champion

The title of German Relay Champion (Mixed/FF/MM) will only be awarded to relay teams in

the Elite category; all relay teams will receive certificates.

Winner of the combined classification & winner of the combined relay classification

The awards winner of the combined classification and winner of the combined relay classification will be awarded to participants in the combined overall classification of the elite category and open category; all individual participants and all relay teams will receive certificates.

Fun Champion & Fun Champion Relay

The Fun Champion and Fun Champion Relay awards will be presented to participants in the Fun category; all individual participants and all relay teams will receive certificates.

Running course

and

timekeeping:

Synthetic running track and grass (spikes up to 6 mm in length permitted);

electronically supported manual timing.

Shooting ranges: 18+ 1 competition laser shooting lanes (Hit&Miss laser targets with external display screens

and shooting tables with support mats) as well as 10 separate shooting lanes for warm up. A

limited number of laser pistols can be hired for a fee.

Qualification for the final:

If there are more than 18 total entries per age group in the Elite and Open competition categories, preliminary heats will be held to allocate starting places in the finals in accordance with the DVMF competition regulations for Laser Run. The same applies to the mixed relay teams. In the Fun category, if there are more than 18 entries per age group, several heats will take place; the participants will be ranked in the order of their finishing times.

Entries: DVMF regional associations, clubs and schools register their participants and supervisors from the

May 28, 2025 on the portal www.Laser-Run.de. If not already done, registration is required beforehand. For the Open category and the Fun category, participants/guardians can also register themselves (or their legal guardians in the case of minors) in accordance with the above

requirements.

The entry confirmation will be sent by e-mail after receipt of the entry fee (and any applicable rental fee for pistols) and must be presented at check-in.

Entry deadline: Monday, June 30, 2025.

Entry fee: Elite category and Open category: 30€ per individual participant, 30€ per relay

team; Fun category: 20 € per individual participant, 20 € per relay team.

Rental fee for laser pistols (if available): 5€ (per competition).

Rental pistols will be reserved in the order in which the entry fee and rental fee are received in

full.

Liability: The organizer and host assume no liability for accidents, loss of items and damage of any

kind. In all other respects, the statutory regulations apply.

Preliminary schedule: 08:00 am: Start of shooting at both laser shooting ranges 08:15 hrs:

Technical briefing

09:00 am: Competition with the start of the first run of the elite category.

The order of the races depends on the number of entries in the individual age groups. The individual heats will start first, followed by the relay heats. If qualification heats are required, these will take place at least two hours

before the corresponding final heats.

From 15:30 hrs: Award ceremony

The final schedule will be published on July 2, 2025 at www.Laser-Run.de.

Accommodati on & meals:

Participants are responsible for their own accommodation. There is a wide range of accommodation available in and around Nuremberg.

A wide range of food and drinks is available on site.

Miscellaneous: On the entire competition grounds, shooting practice is only permitted at the competition

laser shooting range (during the warm-up) and at the separate break-in laser shooting range,

as well as in separately marked areas if necessary.

Data processing and utilization:

- (1) The personal data provided by the participant when registering will be stored and processed only for the purposes of holding and running the event, compiling and maintaining ranking lists and providing information about other Laser Run competitions. This applies in particular to the data required for payment processing. By registering, the participant consents to the storage of data for these purposes.
- (2) By registering, the participant agrees that his/her surname, first name, year of birth, club, school and national association may be used for start and result lists and that photos, film footage and interviews taken in connection with his/her participation in the event may be distributed and published nationally and internationally, in particular on the Internet, without any claim to remuneration.
- (3) In the case of collective registrations, the applicant declares that he has informed each of his registered athletes of paragraphs (1) and (2) and that they or their parents (in the case of minors) have given their consent.
- (4) Participants may withdraw their consent given in accordance with paragraphs (1) and (2) with effect for the future. If the withdrawal takes place before the competition, participation in the competition is not possible.

Equality:

For reasons of simplification and for better readability, only one gender-specific form is used in this invitation to tender. This is not intended to imply discrimination of any kind against the other gender within the meaning of Section 1 AGG.
