The UIPM – Union Internationale de Pentathlon Moderne, together with the South African Modern Pentathlon Federation (SAMPA), has the pleasure of inviting a delegation of your country to participate in the **UIPM 2026 Masters World Championships** to be held in Durbanville, Cape Town, South Africa, from 29 September 2026 - 4 October 2026.

The following formats are being offered:

- Modern Pentathlon with Riding
- Modern Pentathlon with Obstacle
- Modern Pentathlon with Riding and Obstacle (*(Fencing, Swimming, Laser Run once)*)
- Tetrathlon (*Fencing, Swimming, Laser Run*)
- Open Africa Masters Laser Run

### **COMPETITION FORMAT/ RULES**

The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules and Regulations.

Swimming:	25m Indoor pool
Fencing:	9 pistes indoor
Laser Run:	36+2 shooting range with laser targets (EcoAims LTS600)
Running Course:	Grass surface
Obstacle:	outdoor, straight-line, grass surface, official UIPM Youth course and rules for the course applies, bar on the finish wall for 60+ and 70+ (Individuals and Relays)
Riding:	Max 80cm, 8 Obstacle, no double. A limited number of horses (book your place in advance).

### **Notes**

- Categories and distances will follow UIPM rules.
- Unlimited number of individuals can register with a valid UIPM ID number.
- Masters age groups: 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+, 70+ for Individuals, 30+, 60+ for Teams and Relays.
- Pentathlon with Riding: Fencing, Riding, Swimming, Laser Run.
- Pentathlon with Obstacle: Fencing, Swimming, Obstacle, Laser Run.
- Tetrathlon: Fencing, Swimming, Laser Run.

### **WELCOME DINNER**

All athletes, coaches, officials and supporters are invited to a welcome dinner on the terrace at the Durbanville Protea Hotel on the evening of Wednesday 30 September 2026 from 18:00.

The cost of the welcome dinner is included in the accreditation fee. Delegates that are not accredited are welcome to attend the welcome dinner at a cost of 25€ per person.

### **CLOSING CEREMONY**

All athletes, coaches, officials and supporters are invited to a welcome dinner on the terrace at the Durbanville Protea Hotel on the evening of Saturday 3 October 2026.

The cost of the closing ceremony is included in the accreditation fee. Delegates that are not accredited are welcome to attend the closing ceremony at a cost of 40€ per person.

### **ACCOMMODATION**

Participants will be accommodated at the Protea Hotel Durbanville and Tygervalley respectively (3\* hotels). The Technical Meeting will be at Fairmont High School, Durbanville and the LOC Office will also be located at the Fairmont High School. Rooms are reserved on a first registered first served basis.

The Protea Hotel Durbanville offers the following rooms:

### **TRANSPORT**

Please ensure that all selected activities are correct before submission, as these will form the basis of your registration and billing. The entry link will follow shortly.

### ATHLETES LICENSES

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they have a valid Athletes License. Registration is not possible without a License Number. If an athlete does not have a license, they will not be allowed to take part in the competition. You are reminded of Rule 1.12.1 i).

### INSURANCE

According to UIPM Rules, all members of attending delegations should insure themselves in case of accidental injury and illness.

The organizer will not accept any financial liability or loss, injury or illness that occurred to any participant and or member of the delegation.

### **VISAS & VACCINATIONS**

Visiting NFs should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into South Africa prior travelling to the event. The LOC cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas but can provide specific letters of invitation if needed.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

**All Participant "athletes, coach or team doctor" are kindly requested to wear their official national uniform at the competition. Please also bring a track/recording of your anthem and a national flag (120 x 80 cm).**

Expected Weather conditions: The average maximum daytime temperature in Cape Town in Sept/Oct lies at 22°C (71,6°F). The average minimum temperature goes down to around 11°C (51.8°F) (often the minimum temperature is noted at night).

Voltage: 220 V

### **LASER PISTOLS/SIMULATORS**

The use of laser pistols/simulators are permitted in South Africa, with no specific licensing conditions.

The South African Modern Pentathlon Association is in the process of consulting with the Airports Company of South Africa to provide delegations with detailed guidance on the procedures for arrivals and departures procedures at the competition airports Cape Town International Airport. For delegates transferring via another South African airport, please ensure that you confirm carriage of your laser pistol/simulator with the particular airline as their rules and regulations differ.
